I also empower the trainer to withdraw the undermentioned amounts on my behalf:

1. Monthly Basic Maintenance Charges.
2. Commission to trainer & jockey as specified in the Madras Race Club Rules of Racing.
3. Payment of amount due to stable employees.
4. Payment to other Clubs.

No amounts other than those specified above will be withdrawn unless specific authority is given in writing by the owner.

\*I also empower the Trainer who holds a licence under the Madras Race Club Rules to enter, scratch and declare horses under the Rules of any of the Turf Authorities of India.

I also empower the Secretary, Madras Race Club to pay Basic Maintenance Charges to the Trainer from my racing account with Madras Race Club as and when due and also transfer money from my joint account, if any, to my other account or vice versa.

I also authorise the Trainer to Pay / Receive / Buy / Sell on my behalf

In the event of there being a overdue debit balance in any of my accounts, and in the event of me being called upon to make good the same. I hereby expressly authorise and empower the Madras Race Club to sell any of the horses or my share in any of the horses registered in my name, by auction and to recover out of the sale proceeds thereof any of the dues to the Madras Race Club.

I further agree to record and declare that if there be a default in payment of Basic Maintenance Charges to any trainer holding an "A" Licence with the Madras Race Club due to inadequacy of the funds in my account with the Madras Race Club or, due to any other reason whatsoever. I hereby authorise the Madras Race Club to sell any of the horses or my share in any of the horses registered in my name by a public auction, and out of the sale proceeds to pay to the Trainer the arrears of the Basic Maintenance Charges.

**Explanatory note with regard to the General Conditions for sale of horses by public auction in the event of default of payment by owners.**

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

- (i) Since the horse/s or the share of an owner/owners in any of the horse/s registered in the name of an owner/s is to be sold by Auction on there being a debit balance in the account of owner/s concerned after such owner/s has been called upon to make good the same, two such letters by registered post A.D. will be sent to such owner/s in advance calling upon him/them to make the payment of his or their dues before the horse/s or owner/s share/s is put up for sale by Auction.
- (ii) Such Auction will be held, as far as possible, only during the Udthagamandalam or Madras Racing Season on a race day after the races scheduled for that race day have been run or any other day at the discretion of the stewards.
- (iii) If any horse/s to be so auctioned does not invite single bid, such a horse/s will be re-auctioned after a fortnight.
- (iv) If again at the second auction the horse/s does not invite a single bid, the Madras Race Club and or Trainer would be entitled to give away such a horse/s to a Riding School to any person desiring to use the horse/s as a hack or to a good home for animals.

If however, in spite of efforts to find a home for the horse/s concerned if it does not become possible to do so, Madras Race Club will again inform the owner/s concerned in writing that such owner/s should remove the said horse/s from the premises of the Madras Race Club within a fortnight of the date of such letter and also intimate that in the alternative the Madras Race Club will be reluctantly compelled to put down the said horse/s on humane grounds and in any of the aforesaid events the Madras Race Club will not be liable or responsible to the owner/s concerned in any way or manner whatsoever.
